OCSC is offering a total of \$1,000 in scholarship awards to qualified candidates. The applicant must be a current high school senior, graduating in 2026, and have a post-graduation plan to attend a two year or four year institution, a technical or trade school, or an apprenticeship program. In addition, the qualified candidates must meet one of the following qualifying requirements:

- Current Swimmer – Must be an active OCSC swimmer during the 2025-2026 season.
- Previous Swimmer – Must have participated in at least one OCSC season from 2019 to 2026.
- Volunteer – Must have volunteered with OCSC within the past four years.

At OCSC, we believe that swimming is more than just a sport—it's about building character, fostering teamwork, and giving back to the community that supports us. Community involvement and volunteerism are at the heart of our club's mission, shaping not only strong athletes but also well-rounded individuals.
